Anthony Hall opened the meeting at 6:45. The January meeting minutes were approved as written with no dissents. The Treasurer's report was presented by Vic Koenig. There is a minor \$8 discrepancy that will be corrected shortly, and this month incoming revenues of \$799 were received from dues, donations and fly-in receipts, and \$46 spent on postage and \$285 on the port-o-let rental.

Old Business: Anthony Hall announced that we have had another great indoor Fly-In. Everyone had a great time, and it was noted that someone was able to attract no less than six foam airplane collisions, perhaps due to a magnetic personality.

New business: On Oct 26th there will be a Halloween Funfly with a club sponsored JCRC Non-Traditional Aircraft competition, the winner of which will receive fifty dollars in prize money!

The mowing schedule has been posted by Roland Boles; please contact him or Anthony to volunteer as a standby.

A volunteer is also needed to coordinate the Maker's Faire event. This year there will also be a space inside as well as an area for outdoor flying.

There is a workday scheduled for March 23rd, maintenance to include painting, runway work, ramp for shed, fence & pilot enclosure renovation, and making flush the pilot platforms for mowing.

Skip Weller brought up the need for re-graveling, and several others were in agreement, with two loads being suggested. Also, tree trimming needs to be done, and strong backs and chainsaws will be needed.

Vic Koenig provided a brief discussion of his design and construction techniques to create a lightweight but resilient wing with a foam core, and displayed a Dirty Bird wing he built. This technique was featured in an article in the Senior Pattern Association magazine.
