Discussion ensued about this and it was decided to table the vote until the October meeting in order to have a better idea of what we need and how much money has come in from Hobbytown and other sources. This will give the training committee a chance to look carefully at the requirements.

Tim made a motion that he be allowed to spend up to \$750 out of the current club surplus to procure a metal shed cover for the chill n grill grey shed. Approval was unanimous.

Dan suggested that we not meet at Harbor House due to covid questions. October meeting will be at 6pm. No one objected.

Glenn asked if we would have a Halloween fly-in in October. David Jones suggested it just be an informal fun fly on the Saturday of Halloween and it was agreed to do it during the day from 10 til 3pm.

The issue of an indoor fun fly was briefly discussed.
