

JCRC Meeting Highlights and Meeting Minutes August 25th, 2015

Anthony Hall called the meeting to order at 7:05. The minutes for July were presented. Vic Koenig made a motion to accept, and Mike Starnes seconded. Vic Koenig presented the Treasurer's report, with outlays of \$757, for items including club trainer, power bill, and port-o-let rental. There is a \$12,300 balance.

Anthony Hall thanked everyone for attending the Annual Model Aviation Day event, which brought in \$32 for the Wounded Warrior fund. Jackson Bernard was the overall winner of the funfly, by 2 points. The club picnic is coming up September 5th. Next Thursday will be the last grill night. Everyone attending has had an astonishing lot of fun at these. October 31st will be the Halloween funfly, with a \$25 prize for weirdest aircraft, and a trophy for the overall winner.

Michael Lick brought up how the open gate has sometimes had the lock locked onto the fence, making it inconvenient to unlock, then lock up the fence, at night. There was discussion about scrambling the numbers after unlocking the gate.

Club elections are this November, for the club officers and one board member. Being a club officer is not that difficult and pretty rewarding.

Doug Lindaur talked about the UAS4STEM program offered by AMA. Teams of 4-8, from ages 11-19 will compete using a quad to do a search and rescue operation. The complete kit for this costs \$2000. The homeschooling coop his children attend seemed interested in this concept. Anything that gets kids interested in the hobby is a good thing.

AMA is raising prices in mid-September, but if you renew early you can renew at a discounted rate.
