

JCRC Meeting Highlights and Meeting Minutes July 31, 2018 (rescheduled June meeting)

Tim Edwards called the meeting to order at 6:45. The minutes for June were approved, with a motion to pass by Vic Koenig and Danny Rhudy seconding. Anthony Hall presented the Treasurer's report, with \$25 in dues revenues and \$666 in expenses including internet, power, computer upgrades and portapotty, with a \$9,556 balance remaining (not counting \$5K reserved as an emergency fund).

Old business: National Model Aviation Day & Club Picnic celebration will have grilling, and will need about 5 volunteers to help. The club picnic is scheduled for 9 am August 11th, and several people agreed to bring desserts.

Volunteers will also be needed for the ETSU event in March. Glenn Ross offers a RTF boxed Revolution plane as a prize, asking that it be reserved for a flyer under 17 years old or someone learning to fly.

It was noted we have \$723 for the rest of the year (\$5263 assets acquired this year -\$4540 disbursements). There were concerns that we may exceed this in expenses, and that we should do better budgeting.

Glenn Ross presented options for flight line canopies. Alan's price is \$4,270 for 12' x 10' x 51'. Lyon's is \$5,616 for a 12' x 10' x 52'. He also figured a 26' long option would be \$2,135. He suggested adding 10% to any option. It will take several weeks to deliver and install. There was discussion if an email has to go out to everyone or it could be voted immediately, and concern that there is too much delay. It was noted that most people hang out on the lower end side. There were concerns about making sure ground supports would be OK with the city, that the posts might make it hard to maneuver planes, high winds and that we needed to keep pilots from getting skin damage. Private donations were mentioned as a way to further or fund the project. It was decided to get more information and to solicit support outside of the meeting.

At 7:15, Tim Edwards asked for a motion to adjourn, that was made by Tim Edwards and seconded by Glenn Ross.
