Member Information

The period for nominating people to run for officer positions for 2022 begins on 1 September and ends on 29 October. You may nominate people for any and all Officer Positions. There will be one vacating Board Member position, the position currently held by Terry Baily.

Nominations should be sent to the Club President, email is acceptable. You can also make nominations during the September and October Meetings or by calling the President with your nomination. Nominations should be provided with enough lead time in time for him to contact nominees to determine if they are willing to serve. The ballot must be finalized 31 days prior to the 30 November Election Meeting.

Extract from Appendix D to JCRC By-Laws, Elections:

JCRC shall have one election per year at the November scheduled meeting. All members in good standing shall be allowed to vote as per membership type (See Appendix A). A simple majority of votes cast (in person and, if allowed, by absentee ballot decides each position contest.

- All members in good standing will be afforded the opportunity to vote either by being present or by absentee ballot.
- The President shall prepare and distribute via e-mail absentee ballots at least thirty days prior to the scheduled November meeting.
- The absentee ballots will contain all nominations received by 31 days prior to the scheduled November meeting and a designated write in place for each open position (Officer or Board Member), as well as any other item announced for a vote at that meeting.
- Only those absentee ballots received by the Saturday prior to the scheduled November meeting will be counted during the November meeting.

As of this newsletter, the following positions will be vacant and require nominations:

- **Board Member for period 2022 through 2027** (currently held by Terry Bailey)
- Newsletter Editor (currently held by Glenn Ross)

Nominations can be made for all other Officer positions as well, but in all cases, please approach whomever you wish to nominate for an office and determine if they are willing to serve – <u>before nominating them</u>.

Nominations for the vacating Board position require the nominee has previously served as an Officer of JCRC and the nominee be a member in good standing.

Nominations for Officer Positions require the nominee be a member in good standing.

Lastly, you can nominate yourself, as long as you assure yourself you will serve if elected.
