AMA Updates

Following is information provided by AMA concerning registering our aircraft with the FAA:

FAA Registration Demystified

The FAA has updated the Drone Zone website to be compliant with Remote ID, a step that recreational users are not required to comply with until September 2023. The current version of the website requests that recreational users enter information for each of their UAS upon registration and renewal. AMA felt that this request was in error and has been in discussions with the FAA regarding this latest update. The FAA has investigated our concerns and has informed us that it is working to resolve the issue. Until this issue is resolved, AMA has created a guided walk-through for members to follow when registering or renewing with the FAA.

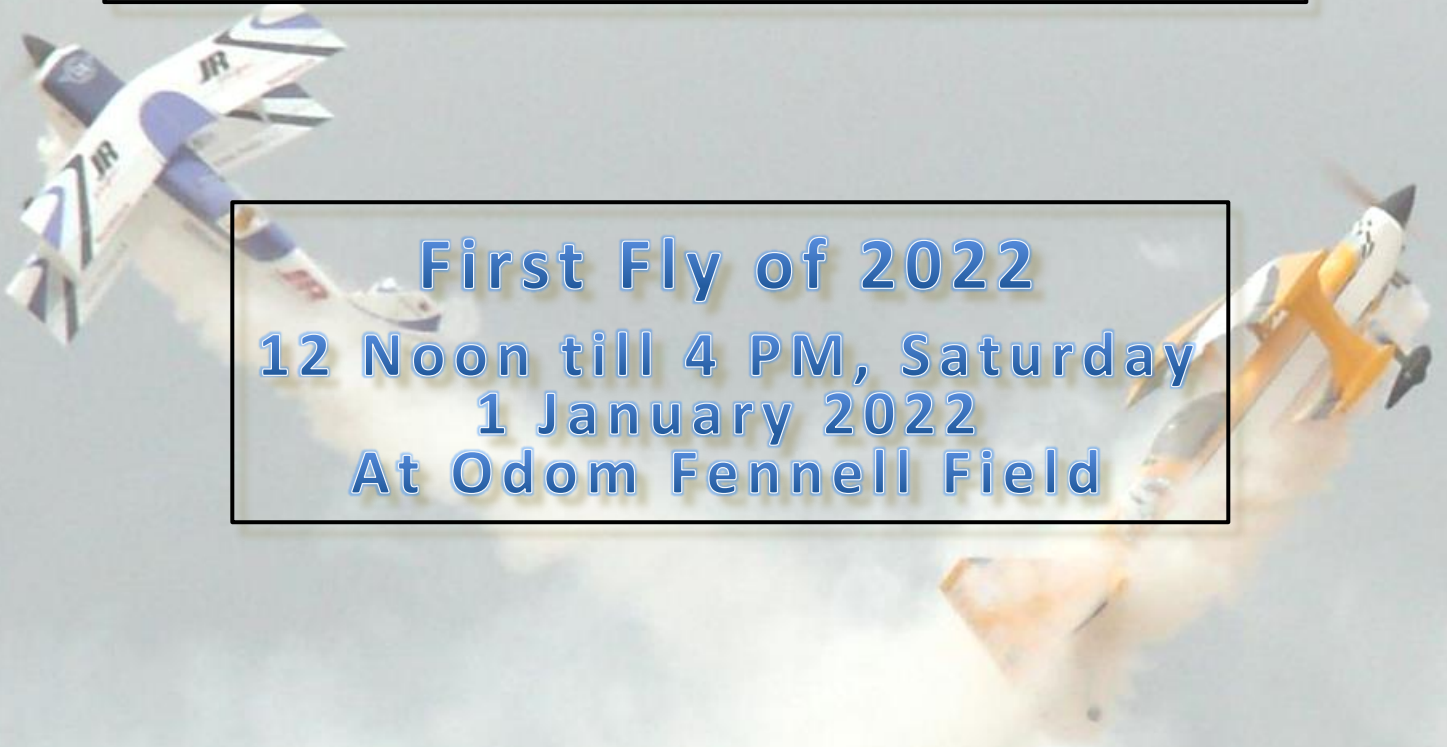
