Recipes from the flight crew:
Ann"s Pinneapple Cake
Ingredients:
2 c. all-purpose flour
2 c. sugar
2 eggs
1 tsp. baking soda
1 tsp. vanilla
pinch salt
1 – 20 oz. can of crushed pineapple
(undrained) in its own juice – not syrup
1 c chopped nuts, optional

Cream Cheese Frosting: 1/2 cup (1 stick) butter, softened 1-8 oz. cream cheese, softened 1 tsp. vanilla 1 1/2 cup confectioners sugar Coconut for garnish is optional

Preheat oven to 350°. Mix all of the cake ingredients together in a bowl. Pour into a greased 9X13 inch pan and bake at 350 for 35 – 40 minutes (until top is golden brown).

Frosting:

Beat butter, cream cheese and vanilla together until creamy. Gradually mix in powdered sugar. Frost cake with cream cheese frosting while still warm. Sprinkle with chopped nuts if desired. Enjoy!

DRIVING DIRECTIONS

From I-26 take Exit 10 - Eastern Star Road
If Exiting from I-26E, Make a Right Turn onto Eastern Star Road,
If Exiting from I-26W, Make a Left Turn onto Eastern Star Road
travel on Eastern Star Road for approximately 0.7 miles,
make a right turn onto Winchester Drive. Travel on Winchester
Drive for approximately 0.2 miles, make a left turn onto Lancaster
Road, continue on Lancaster Road for approximately 0.4 miles,
the entrance is on the right.

Field Information:

Mr Cline has four to five days to to field improvements and such. It was discussed at the last meeting that there would be a some improvements done on April 15 such as the weed killer to be handled by Mr. Skip Weller and the curtains are to be removed by Mr Vic Koenig. The other days will be scheduled at a later date and discussed at the meetings.

At the last meeting we scheduled 15 April for the Spring Work day to remove the Panels (Mr Koenig), apply weed killer (Mr Weller) and some general Clean-up. Mr Cline anticipates a few more work days during the year and these will be discussed and scheduled at subsequent membership meetings. I am happy to report that at the work day the following was accomplished:

- -The hedges at the T33 were trimmed.
- -Ends of the runway were edged.
- -The felt panels were removed from the charging shed, rolled and stowed away.
- -The flight box was cleaned.
- -The refrigerator and microwave was cleaned.
- -The windsock was replaced.
- -Trash was picked up from the woods behind the big shed.
- -The gravel was racked as well.
- -A four inch cap block was positioned under the north corner of the pavilion slab and a plan to reinforce the washed out edges with bricks and foam was made.

I wanted to say a big thank you to all those who attended and the flight club and field looking great again. If anyone has any other suggestions on improvements please let me or Mr Cline know so that it can be addressed and resolved.
