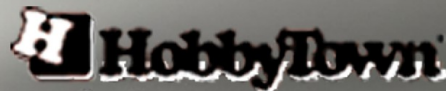

Also we will need help for the future events not only working different parts of the event but also getting the word out to the public about the club and the events.



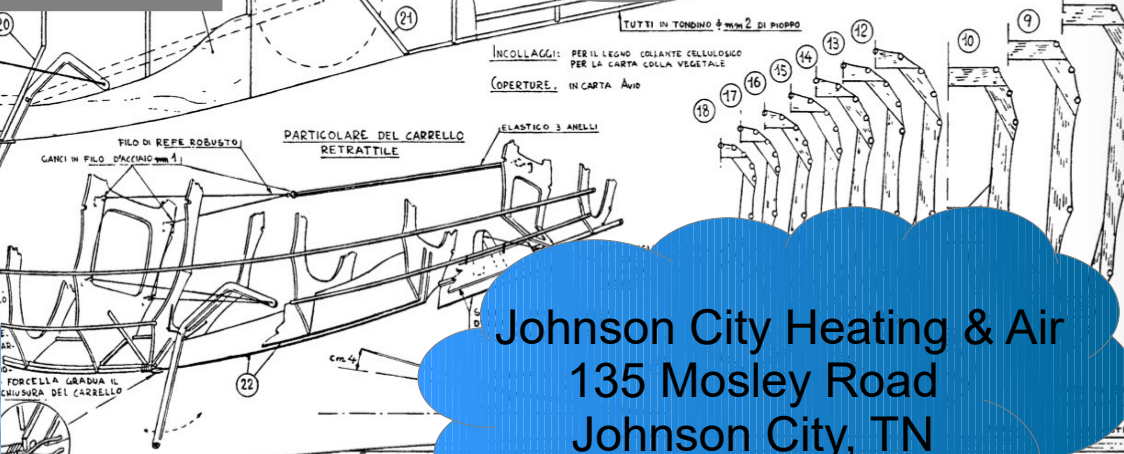
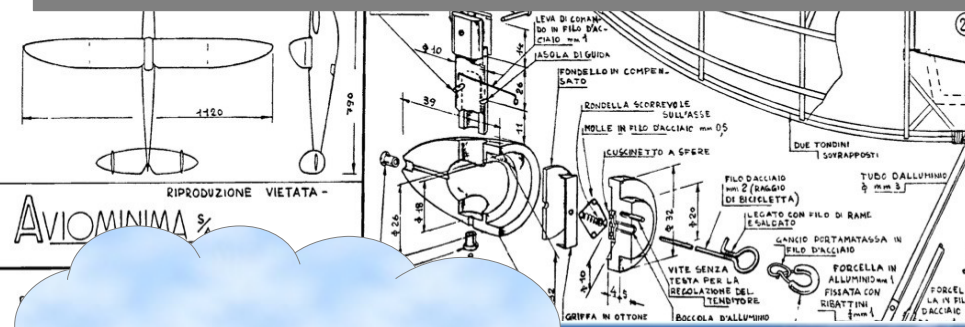
Congratulations to Nathan Willard on his first flight with Eddie Cline. Even his Father (Matt Willard) got in on the fun and flew with Eddie to.
